NEW INSTRUCTIONS FOR CHURCHES IN THE ORANGE ZONE

Last week, the Quebec government announced its intention to increase to 100 the maximum number of people admitted to places of worship for liturgical celebrations in the Orange Zone. We have learned some new details about the changes to the protocol for places of worship made by the Ministry of Public Health. Here are the instructions to be followed as of March 8, in our diocese.

TRIBUTE TO THE VICTIMS OF COVID-19



The government of Quebec plans to mark one year since the beginning of the state of emergency brought on by the coronavirus by remembering its many victims. The official hour-long ceremony will take place, starting at noon.

At the end of this ceremony, people are asked to observe a moment of silence. They would like the churches of Quebec to ring their bells following this moment. Specifically, they ask the churches to start ringing at 1:02 p.m., for a duration of three minutes.

They also request that, where possible, parishes prepare an outdoor place where people could go to meditate during the day and leave a rose or a candle. Such a space will be set up at the Calvary of Notre-Dame cemetery in Gatineau, but all of us could prepare something similar in our neighborhoods and villages. This would be a concrete way for our Christian communities to show their solidarity with our neighbourhoods.
