MEASURES IN FORCE

Québec Premier François Legault announced that the situation in the Outaouais has improved sufficiently that the emergency measures decreed in the region since April 1 will be revoked as of May 17, 2021. This means that the curfew will be changed from 8:00 pm to 9:30 pm, that high schools will be reopened as well as non-essential businesses.

Please note that places of worship are limited to 25 participants. This maximum number of people also applies to funerals and weddings.

NOMINATIONS

- 1. Archbishop Durocher has accepted the resignation of Fr. Bernard Cantin, Eudist, as parish priest in solidum of the cathedral parish of Saint Joseph. Fr. Papy Manengo, also parish priest in solidum of this parish, will continue as sole parish priest, effective June 27.
- Archbishop Durocher has accepted the resignation of Fr. Yves Mayer as parish priest of the parishes of Saint Paul (Aylmer) and Saint Médard (Rapide Deschênes). Fr. Charles Fournier, Marist -- presently administrator of the parish cathedral of Notre-Dame in Ottawa -will replace him has parish priest of both parishes, effective July 25.

EXEMPTION FROM THE DIOCESAN CONTRIBUTION DUE TO THE PANDEMIC

During its regular meeting on April 19, the Diocesan Council for Economic Affairs decided to grant parishes an exemption of 1/50 of their 2021 diocesan contributions for each Sunday of the period from January 10 to February 21, 2021. The credit for the seven Sundays when the churches had been closed at the request of the government for sanitary measures will be granted with the invoice of the diocesan contribution for the second quarter of 2021. If parishes have decided to extend the closure of their church after February 21, the exemption does not apply for additional Sundays. Parishes that have questions or particular difficulties for their finances are invited to contact the diocese to discuss them. This is the second time in a year that the diocese has granted such exemption due to the health crisis. The objective is to help each parish face the decrease in revenue from regular collections.
